THIS SKILL WILL BE DEVELOPED THROUGH THE ANALYSIS AND IN-DEPTH STUDY OF TOPICS AND CASE STUDIES RELATED TO: STRATEGIC LEADERSHIP AND SOFT SKILLS, INTERNATIONAL SECURITY, INDUSTRIAL POLICY AS WELL AS NATIONAL AND INTERNATIONAL DEFENCE & SECURITY POLICY, INTERNATIONAL LAW IN THE MULTI-DOMAIN AND TO THE IMPACT OF EMERGING TECHNOLOGIES AND THE DIGITAL POWER. THE MULTI-DOMAIN TEACHING APPROACH USES INNOVATIVE METHODOLOGIES, INCLUDING ROLE-PLAYING AND WAR-GAMING EXERCISES, WHICH TOGETHER ALLOW FOR THE CREATION OF NATIONAL AND INTERNATIONAL NETWORKS.
DELIVERY METHOD AND PROGRAMME	<p>THE COURSE IS DELIVERED IN TWO PHASES: THE FIRST IS IN-PERSON, IN ITALIAN AND PARTLY IN ENGLISH. AT THE END OF THE COURSE STUDENTS OBTAIN THE IASD QUALIFICATION ONLY; THE SECOND PHASE IS DISTANCE LEARNING (ASYNCHRONOUS E-LEARNING) IN ITALIAN, AVAILABLE ON A VOLUNTARY BASIS, USEFUL FOR OBTAINING THE 2ND LEVEL MASTER'S DEGREE IN 'GLOBAL STRATEGY AND SECURITY (GSS)'.</p> <p>THE IN-PERSON PHASE IS DIVIDED INTO THREE DISCIPLINARY AREAS: THE FIRST, 'STRATEGIC LEADERSHIP AND SOFT SKILLS IN COMPLEXITY', LASTS 5 WEEKS; THE SECOND, 'INTERNATIONAL SCENARIO AND POLICY', LASTS 5 WEEKS (IN ENGLISH AND OVERLAPPING WITH THE INTERNATIONAL CAPSTONE COURSE - ICC); THE THIRD IS 'DEFENCE AND SECURITY STRATEGY', LASTING 5 WEEKS.</p> <p>EACH DISCIPLINARY AREA IS MADE UP OF THEMATIC SUB-MODULES DELIVERED THROUGH LECTURES, SEMINARS, CONFERENCES, ROUND TABLES, ROLE PLAYS AND/OR EXERCISES, WITH IN-DEPTH ANALYSIS OF CASE STUDIES AND SPECIFIC ASSIGNED TOPICS.</p> <p>THE IN-PERSON PHASE IS COMPLETED BY A WEEK DEDICATED TO WARGAMING AND DAYS DEDICATED TO NATIONAL AND/OR INTERNATIONAL 'PRACTICAL AND/OR OBSERVATION TRAINING MODULES' AT CONSTITUTIONAL OR CONSTITUTIONALLY SIGNIFICANT BODIES (PRESIDENCY OF THE REPUBLIC AND OF THE COUNCIL, CHAMBER OF DEPUTIES, SENATE, CONSTITUTIONAL COURT, COUNCIL OF STATE), JOINT OR SINGLE SERVICE LEVEL HQs/BODIES, RESEARCH CENTRES.</p> <p>THE FIRST PHASE INVOLVES THE DEVELOPMENT OF A FINAL PROJECT WORK.</p> <p>THE DISTANCE LEARNING PHASE IS DIVIDED INTO TWO MODULES: THE FIRST IS 'INTERNATIONAL LAW IN THE MULTIDOMAIN' AND THE SECOND IS 'EMERGING TECHNOLOGIES AND DIGITAL POWER'.</p> <p>THE SECOND PHASE CONCLUDES WITH AN EXAM TO OBTAIN THE 2ND LEVEL MASTER'S DEGREE.</p>
