Ana Isabel Xavier is an Associate Professor in International Relations at the Autonomous University of Lisbon (UAL) and at ISCTE-IUL (Portugal). She is an integrated researcher at the Centre for International Studies (CEI-IUL), where she coordinated the project "E(U) lections'19: think, decide, change!", funded by the European Commission's "Europe for Citizens" program (2019- 2021). Since 2019, she is a member of the European consortium "League of European Defence experts and researchers (Le@der)"- Multiple Framework contract to provide foreign policy expertise (EP/EXPO/B/FWC/2019-01 Lot 4 Security and Defence).

She holds a PhD in International Relations from the Faculty of Economics of the University of Coimbra (specialization in European Studies), with a dissertation entitled "The European Union and Human Security: a crisis management player in search of a strategic culture? Analysis and prospective considerations." (2011). She holds a Master's degree in Sociology of Development and Social Transformation (2006) and a degree in International Relations (2003) from the same Faculty. She holds a postgraduate degree (2005) in Human Rights and Democratization from the Faculty of Law of the University of Coimbra.

Member of the board of the Portuguese Atlantic Commission since October 2020. Auditor of the National Defence Course (2011/2012) she was President of the Board of the Association of Auditors of National Defence Courses (2014-2016). Auditor of the Defence Course for Young People (2004), she was President of the Board of DECIDE – Association of Young Auditors for Defence, Security and Citizenship (2009-2013).

From March 2015 to February 2017, she served as a Deputy Director at the Directorate of the National Defence (MoD) and was awarded the *Cruz del Mérito Aeronáutico con Distintivo Blanco* by the Government of Spain (August 2016) and by the Government of Portugal with the First Class National Defense medal (December 2017).

She is an analyst of international affairs at RTP – Portuguese Public Radio and Television, with a weekly five minutes magazine on Europe besides other participations in a daily basis.
